Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Swan Rake and Limer Rake, Hollinsclough

Prohibition of all traffic except horses, pedestrians, and pedal cyclists

Statement of Reasons

To prevent the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road and to preserve the character of the road for it to remain suitable for use by cyclists and persons on horseback or on foot in accordance with Staffordshire County Council's statutory duty as highway authority under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 requiring the expeditious, convenient, and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic including pedestrians, and for preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road.

Schedule

Swan Rake from its junction with New Road for 425 metres in a westerly and south-westerly direction to its junction with FP No.30 Hollinsclough.

Limers Rake from its junction with FP No. 22 Hollinsclough for 585 metres in a north-easterly, northerly, and north-westerly direction to its junction with Swan Rake.
