**ADVENTURE BIKE RIDER FESTIVAL ACCIDENT WAIVER, RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY AND  
ASSIGNMENT OF CLAIMS**

Event organisers will accept no responsibility for the actions of any person attending the event. By signing this form each attendee accepts that:

- 1) Motorcycles are considered dangerous and accidents causing death, bodily injury, disability and property damage can, and do, happen;
- 2) It is each attendee's responsibility to ensure that their motorcycle is road legal / worthy and correctly insured.
- 3) Attendees are responsible for their own actions and any consequences of their actions when riding a motorcycle.
- 4) Members may video record events and ride outs using helmet / bike cams.

**EVENTS DEPICTED IN THESE VIDEOS ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RIDERS.**

**As consideration for being allowed to participate in the event(s) described below I agree:**

1. I acknowledge that motorcycle activity is a potentially hazardous activity which can be a test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of riders equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to organizers, participants, volunteers, spectators, agents. These risks are not only inherent to riders, but are also present for passengers, spectators and volunteers. I hereby assume all the risks of participating, viewing and/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities organizing or conducting this event and hereby release them of all possible liability. I certify I am at least 18 years old. I promise not to sue and agree to pay all court costs and all legal fees that result from my action, civil or otherwise.

2. I certify that I am physically fit with no known physical or mental impairment and have prepared for participation in the event(s). I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability form will be used by the event holders and organizers of the event(s), in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said events. I certify that I am not under the influence of any narcotic, alcohol or other drug that may impair my understanding or judgement and that I will not at any time during the event(s) operate my motorcycle under

the influence of any narcotic, alcohol or drug. I certify that I have fully adequate insurance to cover all medical claims, the motorcycle and any other equipment and any damage or liability I may ultimately be found responsible for, during all travel to the point of my entry into the event, the event, the period of my return to my final destination. I further certify that I have all the insurance required by law and I am licensed and competent to operate a motorcycle in a safe manner and my license has all motorcycle endorsements or certificates required by my country of residence.

3. In consideration of my being permitted to participate in this event, I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns as follows: (A) Waive, Release and Discharge from any and all liability for my death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to me during the event or during my travelling to and from this event, THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OR PERSONS: event organisers, ride organizers, representatives, sponsors, agents, volunteers and (B) indemnify and Hold Harmless the entities or persons mentioned in this paragraph from any and all liabilities or claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of any of my actions during this event.

Accordingly, I do hereby release and discharge rally organisers its officers, ride organizers and representatives from all claims, demands, and causes of action of every kind whatsoever for any death, damages and /or injuries which may result from my participation in this event. This shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

4. I hereby consent to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and or illnesses during the event(s). I agree to pay for any and all costs related to medical response, treatment and transport on my behalf.

5. I certify I will wear the personal protective equipment while operating my motorcycle at this event that is or may be required by the UK and that my motorcycle and all required personal protective equipment are in safe operational condition. I agree to abide by the directions/rules given by the organizers of this event and understand that my privilege to ride may be removed without refund if I am in violation of the rules set forth or acting/performing in an unsafe manner, or any manner disruptive to the operation of the event(s).

6. I agree to pay for all expenses (including, but not limited to lodging, food, beverages, gasoline, oil, repairs and maintenance and any other costs or expense I may incur) intending that the organisers shall be totally free of such costs and expense.

7. As additional consideration for being allowed to participate in the event(s), I hereby assign to the organisers any claim I have or might have, in contract or in tort in any way, shape, form or fashion arising out of its action, the actions of other riders or anyone that participates in or comes in contact with participants in the event(s). This assignment is intended by all parties to be a full and complete assignment of any claim I have against the organisers, ride organizers, volunteers and representatives or may have against entities and individuals listed in this paragraph whether directly or through third parties. The intent of the parties is that the organisers, ride organizers, volunteers and representatives shall be liability free with regard to anything in any way connected with the event.

8. I hereby release the organisers from any and all claims based upon or arising out of the use, reproduction, distribution, display or performance of all or any part of the photographs or recording, or any derivative thereof, including any claim of invasion of privacy or right of publicity.

**Adventure Bike Rider Festival 2018 on site off-road course and trail riding**

**The risks you take.**

Trail and off-road riding carries risk. Falls are inevitable. At least one person will fall off on any ride. That person may well be you. If you fall off a motorcycle you may well be hurt. If you are unlucky you can be really hurt. If you are really unlucky, you could be killed. Most falls are uneventful but with a big trail bike weighing over 200kg if your bike falls on you, despite protective gear, it could well hurt a lot.

If you do not want to take the risks inherent in trail and off-road riding, don't come out on your bike or use the off-road course. We cannot control how you react in any given situation. You choose your lines, your speed, your braking and your steering. You decide how much protective gear you wear. You decide your bike, the suitability of your tyres and only you can let your ego outstrip your talent. We can show you trails which you have access to. We are trail guides, not instructors.

In English and Welsh law which governs our contract you are knowingly taking on the inherent and clear risks of moving a motorcycle over some demanding terrain or taking the risks of riding on the road.

If it goes wrong, without negligence on our part, you simply have to take those risks. If you want us to say "fall off and we'll pay you your losses" then don't come out with us or use the off-road course at the event. Stay safe under your duvet and don't take the enjoyment of trail riding because you are not prepared to take the risk.

If the pace or terrain is getting too much for you, or you are feeling nervous about any stretch, tell us. Our marshals will take your bike through the bits you cannot manage or do not want to manage. We actively encourage you to tell us if the terrain or conditions are too much for you. It makes our life a whole lot easier if we are not picking up your bike, administering first aid or attending you waiting for an ambulance.

Your riding colleagues and we will respect you rather more if you take a realistic view of your skill level. Don't be the guy who messes up the riding for everyone by letting your ego get the better of you. We'd rather have a wait for you to arrive safely around the course rather than have to call the riding off because you are hurt or your bike is busted beyond running repair. The quicker riders accept this. This is trail riding, **not** enduro racing.

**I understand there is a real risk of harm, injury or even death from trail riding and off-road riding and I willingly accept those risks. I further confirm that I will tell a marshal if the ride is getting too much for me or any one part of the trail or course is beyond what I think my own abilities or my bike can cope with. If I am a bit of a handy rider, I willingly accept that I might need to wait for slower riders and I don't want anyone to get hurt. I will ride safely and not hassle slower riders or overtake them without being waved past by the rider I am overtaking.**

**I also confirm my motorcycle is road legal and insured for at least 3<sup>rd</sup> party cover.**

**I sincerely affirm that I will not let my ego outstrip my talent and I will tell my guide if I am getting out of my comfort zone.**
